# EUPEN 2001 5th Anniversary Forum

The Fifth European Physics Education Network (EUPEN) anniversary forum will be held in Severinstrasse 199 D-50676 Koln on 6-8 September 2001.

The forum will present, discuss and explore the inquiries of the four EUPEN working groups. It will also discuss research and development work covering physics education, emphasizing new initiatives in physics and multimedia teaching and learning.

The themes and strands of the forum consist of the following: 1. Quality assurance and evaluation in physics curricula (a scent of physics); 2. First and

second cycle physics degrees in the context of the Bologna Declaration; 3. Networking opportunities for specialization in physics; 4.
