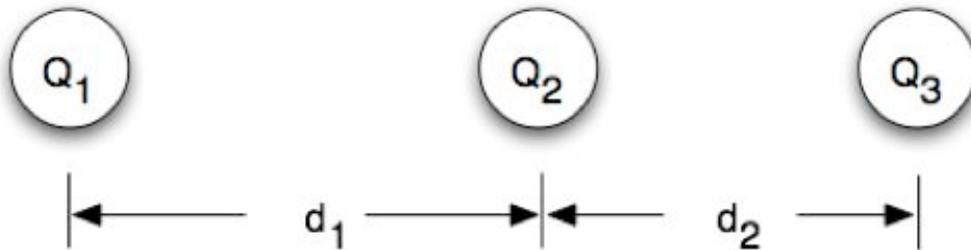


Three charges are arranged along a line as shown in the figure below. The sizes of the charges and the distances are not to scale.



If $d_1 = d$ and $d_2 = 3d$,
while $Q_1 = Q$ and $Q_3 = 4Q$, then

1. $|F_{Q_1 \rightarrow Q_2}| > |F_{Q_3 \rightarrow Q_2}|$

2. $|F_{Q_1 \rightarrow Q_2}| > |F_{Q_3 \rightarrow Q_2}|$

3. $|F_{Q_1 \rightarrow Q_2}| > |F_{Q_3 \rightarrow Q_2}|$

4. You can't tell without knowing the size of Q_2 .
